Premiums Written since 2002 includes "Subsidies appropriated for premiums, etc." The subsidies were set up to refund a part of the cumulative invested profits of the Automobile Liability Reinsurance Special Account in order to appropriate for a part of the premiums, and policyholders pay the premiums less the subsidies.
